

Guidelines for Artwork Consideration

Please consider donating the use of your original artwork for the Annual CASA Holiday Greeting Card Fundraising Project. The proceeds raised from selling these packaged holiday cards remain in NH to help defray costs for CASA's important work.

Your artwork, if selected by the CASA Committee, will be part of a very popular series of cards selling 50,000 to 75,000 cards annually. The print quality on these 4.5"x 6" cards is excellent. This is a terrific publishing opportunity and a great way to use your talent to support a valuable organization.

Selection Guidelines

Medium: photographs, watercolor, acrylics, oil, pastels, drawings, etc.

Themes: winter seasonal, Religious Holidays(Christmas/Hanukkah - liturgical and classic motifs): NH motifs; colorful. Previous published artwork (i.e. children's book illustration) will be considered if you provide appropriate copyright permission.

Additional themes may include: multi-cultural children, lively, colorful; showing peace and friendship around the world.

Preference is given to NH residents.

Review: We can only accept good quality color copies; i.e. color photos, color laser copies, or slides. No original art at this time please. Slides or laser proofs preferred.

All ages welcomed! Teachers: Consider a class project.

Submission Deadline: Artwork is due by February 15, 2009

If you would like your entry returned please include a self-addressed stamped envelope. Please do not send original artwork at this time.

The committee will be choosing 8 -12 images for the 2009 collection. We typically print 1,000-10,000 of each design. Your name and copyright will appear on the back of the card and you will receive 2 packs containing 20 cards of your design. You retain full copyright and your artwork will be returned to you after scanning.
